



GUIDE TO PYO STRAWBERRIES

PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY BEFORE ARRIVING AT THE FARM

We're thrilled to be opening our strawberry patches for the 2020 PYO season and can't wait to see you out in the fields!

Due to the current health crisis, we've made a host of modifications to our Pick-Your-Own protocols. To ensure the health and well-being of our guests, staff, and community, we ask that EVERYONE read the information below PRIOR to visiting the farm and adhere strictly to the practices outlined.

Pick-Your-Own Hours: Open Daily 8AM – 6PM

Location: To better ensure a safe and positive picking experience for all, we've planted new fields in new locations across the farm. Please DO NOT assume that PYO is at the "same old place" that it has been in the past. All guests should follow on-property signage and/or call the farm stand at (603) 926-3721 for up-to-the-minute information PRIOR to arriving.

Weather & Picking Conditions: PYO is open rain or shine, but feel free to call the farm stand at (603) 926-3721 for current updates.

Check-In:

- Weekends: Stop-by the farm stand or feel free to proceed directly to that day's picking field as indicated on our PYO hotline (603) 926-3721.
- Week Days: Always register at the farm stand prior to heading out and staff will direct you that day's picking location.

Pricing:

- By-the-quart: \$7.95 ea
- By-the-pound:
 - \$4.50 per/lb
 - \$3.95 per/lb (+10 pounds)
- PLEASE NOTE: per Governor's Order, personal picking containers are not permitted. Rest assured, 6 - 10 quart recyclable (and re-usable) cardboard picking trays will always be made available (\$1 per/tray).

What to Expect: In response to COVID-19, the new mandates for our PYO include basic social distancing guidelines and an appeal to guests of the farm to follow all good common sense and courtesy. If you or someone in your party is feeling unwell, please stay home. If you're uncomfortable with the current environment, we encourage you to visit us the next soonest possible time. Non-compliant guests will be invited to leave and visit us another day.
